How Does Birdies for Charity Work?

Participants can either make a one-time flat donation or a pledge of \$.01 or more for each birdie made by the PGA TOUR Champions professionals during the 2017 Mitsubishi Electric Classic (official rounds April 14-16).

What is a Birdie?

A "birdie" is a score of one stroke better than "par" for any golf hole on the course. "Par" is the normal expected score of a golf professional on any given hole. For example, on a par 4 hole, a score of 3 is a birdie.



Matching Funds

If an organization receives at least \$1,000 in collected donations, they will qualify for matching funds. This guarantees the charity will receive up to a 10% match.
